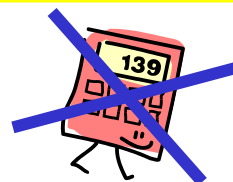


Before you start:

3. Subtracting decimals

How to ...

$$3.9 - 1.2$$

1. line up the decimal points

$$\begin{array}{r} 3.9 \\ 1.2 \\ \hline 2.7 \end{array}$$

2. start here

3. Remember it is top subtract the bottom

$$12.4 - 3.62$$

we have to do some 'borrowing'

$$\begin{array}{r} 12.40 \\ 3.62 \\ \hline 8.78 \end{array}$$

start

← fill the space with a '0'

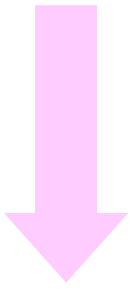
$$12.041 - 8.57$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 12.041 \\ 8.570 \\ \hline 3.471 \end{array}$$

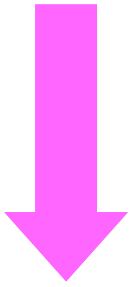

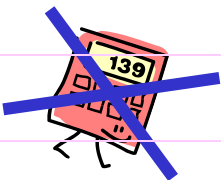
